Sprunt was the architect and lead consultant for this City Learning Centre and new library at Acland Burghley School in Camden.

The project involved combining a new centre on the site of the school designed to encourage the use of IT in education and the wider community with new open learning and library facilities.

Work was carried out while the school remained in operation and the scheme was designed to minimise disruption during construction.

Following the successful completion of the open learning centre Sprunt was commissioned to refurbish the school's entrance and reception, a £140,000 project which was completed during the summer holiday.
